If you notice, the liturgical deacon is wearing a new **dalmatic**. The dalmatic garment has been in use since the 2nd century, and is worn by a deacon in the Eucharistic liturgy. In our liturgy it will function to clearly indicate the liturgical deacon, and also to add liturgical colour to the worship.

The use of a "**prayer bowl**" (a musical instrument) has been introduced to the Wednesday Eucharist to indicate the times for silent mediation after the homily and after communion.
