The new educational wing for our House for the Church (which has been approved by both the congregation and the diocese) will cost approximately \$70,000 in materials. The labour component for this project will be donated by the trades people from the congregation. The \$70,000 will come from the principle investment from the sale of the rectory seven years ago.

The addition of the educational wing will not only allow us the needed space for the current ministries that we are providing, but it will also make the facility more available for use to the wider community, and thereby potentially help us generate operating funds.

Although we will not have to borrow money for the construction of the new wing, we still have a mortgage on the original building that is being paid, and we need to furnish the new multi-purpose rooms.
